

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

KFPA Virtual Festival 2021

1) Will there be a printed program or online schedule available for purchase?

There will be no printed program or online schedule for the KFPA Virtual Festival 2021.

2) I understand there will be “Educational Learning Experiences” live streamed for specific disciplines. Who will be invited to these live streamed sessions?

Discipline specific “*Educational Learning Experiences*” will be provided to all performers through an electronic invitation sent to the email address included in the KFPA online registration process. Only performers will be interactive during these learning sessions provided by their specific Adjudicator.

In addition, parents, teachers, and community members will receive invitations to attend these sessions IF KFPA has access to their email addresses to send the invitation. If someone would like an invitation, please email info@kfpa.ca and indicate the discipline you are interested in attending. Invitations can be shared by forwarding email invitations to those you may feel would enjoy listening to the session(s).

3) I understand that ‘livestream’ sessions are being provided for Speech Arts “Creative Storytelling” and Dance “Technique Classes.” Can I attend these sessions through an email invitation?

Unfortunately, no attendees are invited to these KFPA Host sessions outside of the registered performer(s) and the respective Adjudicators.

4) Can I use my Teacher ID number to view when* my students will be adjudicated?

IF Teacher ID numbers were included at the time of online registration, teachers will be able to view their students ‘marks field’ within each performer’s Class.

*Due to the virtual format, Adjudicators have flexibility as to when they complete their private viewing and adjudication of performers video recordings (within a time frame provided by KFPA). Therefore, an exact date and time of available individual adjudications cannot be provided but will be made available prior to March 12.

5) Can I pay to view various classes throughout the KFPA Virtual Festival 2021?

Unfortunately, there will be no public or private viewing of performance video submissions during the adjudication timeframe.

6) Does that mean that the students’ performances for each class will only viewed by the adjudicator, not the public, teachers or the other students (or families) in the class?

Unfortunately, yes that is the case for this year’s Virtual Festival 2021.

7) Can adjudication be viewed by the general public?

No. KFPA Virtual Festival 2021 adjudication results will only be in a readable and printable format through Registrant Solarislive accounts and My Classes and the 'marks field' comment section.

8) Will performers know who else is competing/participating in their class(es)?

Unfortunately, there will be no schedule available to performers, parents, or teachers for the KFPA Virtual Festival 2021.

9) Where can I access adjudications and in what format will they be provided?

Adjudications will be provided in written format only, through Solarislive My Classes. Only the registrant will be able to read and/or print the written adjudications, and teacher if the Teacher ID was included in the registration process. No audio or video recorded adjudications will be provided.

10) Will teachers have access to their student's adjudication results?

IF students included the Solarislive Teacher ID number in the KFPA online registration process, teachers will have access to the adjudication results through Solarislive Teacher login and My Classes.

11) Will recipients of Scholarships, Encouragement Awards, KFPA Special Awards, Trophies, Plaques and Provincial Recommendations be posted online?

Yes! The KFPA Virtual Festival 2021 recognition process will be the same as in previous years. Award recipients will be listed on our [website](#) and on the KFPA Facebook page.

12) Will there be a Virtual Festival 2021 Honours Concert?
