HARP RULES

Please read specific discipline rules as well as information on Scholarships and Awards at the end of each discipline plus Appendices 2 and 3 before registration.

1. Any accredited or recognized examination Syllabus is to be used as a guide to grade level classes.
2. The **FIRST BAR of each line MUST be numbered in the Adjudicator's music**. A complete score must be provided to the adjudicator, and may not be an unauthorized photocopy. See General Rule 28.
3. Pre-recorded accompaniment **NOT** permitted.
4. MINI-RECITAL: Participants perform **two (2) selections**. This is a Non-Competitive class.
5. Maximum of two (2) music stands will be provided. Please bring your own music stands if you require additional.
6. Classes may be divided. See General Rule 26.

NOTE: Also see General Rules at front of Syllabus.

HARP CLASSES

Scholarships and Provincial Recommendations are based on competitive solos only. Competitive solo class **Additional Repertoire** DOES NOT QUALIFY for Scholarships OR Provincial Recommendation.

Concert Program classes count as one (1) solo class in all disciplines.

GRADE 10 and Up. Time limit thirty (30) minutes. Kamloops Symphony Mentorship Award Concerto. Time limit thirty (30) minutes. MINI-RECITAL <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	Two (2) selections. PRELIM-GRADE 6. Time limit eight (8) minutes. GRADE 7 and Up. Time limit fifteen (15) minutes.

CLASS NAME	DESCRIPTION
HARP DUETS <i>COMPETITIVE</i> for Recommendation to NEW Provincial Duet class OR <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	One (1) selection.
HARP ENSEMBLE <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	One (1) selection. Three (3) or more Harps.
HARP AND OTHER INSTRUMENT OR VOICE <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	One (1) selection. Two (2) participants. Harp will be graded on accompaniment.
FAMILY MUSIC <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	This class is provided to foster music in the home and is open to two (2) or more family members of one (1) family. Accompanist MUST be a member of the family. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two (2) contrasting selections. • Only one (1) folk song permitted.

<p>COMMUNITY MUSIC NON-COMPETITIVE</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Time limit ten (10) minutes. <p>This class is provided to foster music in the community and is open to two (2) or more participants who are from more than one (1) family.</p> <p>Two (2) contrasting selections. Only one (1) folk song permitted. Time limit ten (10) minutes.</p>

SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

1. See General Rules 22 and 45 through 59, and Appendices 2 and 3.
2. **To be considered for scholarships, each solo entry must achieve a minimum mark of 85. Participants MUST ENTER:**
 - GRADES 1 through 6 – Two (2) solo classes.
 - GRADES 7 through DIPLOMA or OPEN – Three (3) solo classes.
3. ADULT, GROUP, and PRELIMINARY CLASSES **DO NOT QUALIFY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS.**
See grey box under HARP CLASSES for list of other solo classes that DO NOT qualify for scholarship.
