



## KFPA 2022 FESTIVAL COVID-19 Safety Plan

**Please ensure you have read and understand this Safety Plan.**

**Please understand with COVID-19, students and their guardians assume all risk and liability by participating in the Kamloops Festival of the Performing Arts.**

### **Vaccination Requirements:**

Proof of full vaccination will be required in indoor spaces for everyone who is eligible to be vaccinated at the time of the Festival.

### **Mask Mandate:**

Masks will be required for everyone age 5 years and older.

### **Facility Entrance:**

Anyone experiencing any covid symptoms or exposed to anyone with covid is asked to not attend.

### **Contact Tracing Requirements:**

Everyone entering a Festival venue must sign in and provide contact phone numbers for contact tracing requirements.

### **Hand Hygiene:**

Hand sanitizer will be at the entrance of each facility to be used when entering.

**Capacity at each venue will be governed by the provincial protocols at the time of the festival. Currently, capacity is restricted to no more than 50 people or 50 percent of capacity, whichever is greater.**

**These guidelines are subject to change based on provincial regulations at the time of the Festival.**
