- A change of selection cannot be made or announced as a change on the stage at performance time. A participant doing so will perform as Non-Competitive for that class.

*VOICE RULES

Please read specific discipline rules as well as information on Scholarships and Awards at the end of each discipline plus Appendices 2 and 3 before registration.

1. Any accredited or recognized examination Syllabus is to be used as a guide to grade level classes
2. The **FIRST BAR of each line MUST be numbered in the Adjudicator's music**. A complete score must be provided to the adjudicator and may not be an unauthorized photocopy. See General Rule 28. For some Folk Songs, printed music may not be available; in such cases, a copy of the words **MUST** be presented to the Adjudicator.
3. Pre-recorded accompaniment **NOT** permitted.
4. MINI-RECITAL: Participants perform **two (2) selections**. This is a Non-Competitive class.
5. KFPA follows the rules for costumes and props as set out in the Provincial Syllabus for Classical Voice. Check the Provincial Syllabus at bcprovincials.com.
6. ADDITIONAL REPERTOIRE is **NOT** to include MUSICAL THEATRE or POPULAR VOCAL.
7. CONCERT PROGRAM may include one **(1)** Musical Theatre. **NOT** to include POPULAR VOCAL.
8. VOCAL VARIETY is **NOT** to include Classical Voice or Musical Theatre selections. See Glossary for styles of selections that are eligible.
9. To be eligible to enter POPULAR VOCAL, a participant **MUST** enter at least **one (1)** CLASSICAL VOICE class **OR one (1)** MUSIC THEATRE class. POPULAR VOCAL is a Non-Competitive class.
10. Classes may be divided. See General Rule 26.

MUSICAL THEATRE RULES

When registering for a Musical Theatre class please use the following format for the title and name of the show: *Feed the Birds from Mary Poppins*

Please read specific discipline rules as well as information on Scholarships and Awards at the end of each discipline plus Appendix 2 and 3 before registration.

1. The **FIRST BAR of each line MUST be numbered in the Adjudicator's music**. A complete score must be provided to the adjudicator, and may not be an unauthorized photocopy. See General Rule 28.
2. Pre-recorded accompaniment **NOT** permitted.
3. To enter Musical Theatre classes, an entry in at least one Classical Voice class is encouraged.
4. Costumes are permitted.
5. Hand held props, that are integral to the performance, are allowed in addition to a single chair as a stage prop.

6. Participants **MUST** provide a verbal introduction of their selections to **set the scene** as they begin their performance. These remarks will not be included in the timing of the selection.
7. With the **EXCEPTION** of appropriate musical and non-verbal communication during a performance, interaction between the performer and the accompanist or any other individual after the introduction of the selection is not permitted.
8. To be eligible for recommendation to the Provincial Festival in Musical Theatre, participants **MUST ENTER** One (1) Musical Theatre Ballad class **AND** One (1) Music Theatre Comedy or Scene class. Check the Provincial Syllabus at **bcprovincials.com** for rules for costumes and props and the format of the Provincial Musical Theatre class.
9. Classes may be divided. See General Rule 26.

NOTE: Also see General Rules at front of Syllabus.

VOICE CLASSES

Scholarships and Provincial Recommendations are based on competitive solos only. Competitive solo classes that **DO NOT QUALIFY** for Scholarships OR Provincial Recommendation include **Additional Repertoire** and **Vocal Variety. Concert Program** classes count as one (1) solo class in all disciplines. Please see final page of Voice section titled Scholarships and Awards.

ALL GROUP CLASSES ARE NON-COMPETITIVE ALL GROUPS SHOULD REGISTER USING GROUP NAME AS IT SHOULD APPEAR IN THE PROGRAM.	
CLASSES MAY BE DIVIDED INTO GENERAL AGE GROUPS: PRIMARY/ELEMENTARY – 11 YEARS and UNDER JUNIOR – 14 YEARS and UNDER INTERMEDIATE – 18 YEARS and UNDER SENIOR/ADULT – 19 YEARS and OVER	
CLASS NAME	DESCRIPTION
MUSICAL THEATRE DUET <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● One (1) selection. ● Harmony optional, staging encouraged.
MUSICAL THEATRE PRODUCTION NUMBER <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● One (1) selection. ● More than one (1) voice per part. ● Solos optional, harmony optional, staging encouraged.
MUSICAL THEATRE TRIO/QUARTET <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● One (1) selection. ● One (1) voice per part. ● Harmony optional, staging encouraged.
POPULAR VOCAL GROUPS <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● One (1) selection. ● Any number of participants. ● All vocal groups MUST BE UNCONDUCTED.
DUET/TRIO/QUARTET <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● One (1) selection. ● One (1) voice per part, harmony required.
FAMILY MUSIC <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	<p>This class is provided to foster music in the home and is open to two (2) or more family members of one (1) family. Accompanist MUST be a member of the family.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Two (2) contrasting selections. ● Only one (1) folk song permitted. ● Time limit ten (10) minutes.
COMMUNITY MUSIC <i>NON-COMPETITIVE</i>	<p>This class is provided to foster music in the community and is open to two (2) or more participants who are from more than one (1) family.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Two (2) contrasting selections. ● Only one (1) folk song permitted. ● Time limit ten (10) minutes.

For **COMPETITIVE GROUPS**, see **CHORAL Discipline**

NOTE: The specific requirements to be eligible for recommendation to the Provincial Festival.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

1. *See General Rules 22 and 45 through 57, and Appendices 2 and 3.
2. *To be considered for Classical Voice scholarships, each solo entry must achieve a minimum mark of 85. Participants **MUST ENTER**:
 - Primary, Elementary, Junior – Two (2) solo classes.

- Intermediate Level A, B, C – Two (2) solo classes.
- Intermediate Level D, Senior, Open – Three (3) solo classes.

NOTE: ONLY Classical Voice classes will count for scholarship eligibility.

3. To be considered for Musical Theatre Adjudicators' Choice Encouragement Award, participants **MUST ENTER:**

- One (1) Musical Theatre Ballad class

AND

- One (1) Musical Theatre Comedy or Scene class (See Appendix 2)
One (1) Classical Voice class is highly recommended but not mandatory.

4. *ADULT and GROUP classes **DO NOT QUALIFY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS.**

See grey box under VOICE CLASSES for list of other solo classes that DO NOT qualify for scholarship.
